*For the last 40 or more years we have been using the English translation of the Mass. This version was done quickly and in many ways lacked a sense of beauty. It was not always faithful to the original. For a number of years the Bishops of the English speaking countries have been working together on a better translation. This work has almost finished.*

*We do not yet know when we shall start using it – it could be a year or more. In this parish we are going to start now by occasionally using the new translation of the Eucharistic prayers.*

*There are problems with translations. In one of the original English versions, the phrase “the prayer he taught us” became the “prairie tortoise!”*
