40th Anniversary of the Church

February 14th 2010 - 6th Sunday of the Year, C

*On Wednesday we begin our 40 day pilgrimage of faith towards Easter, called **Lent**. There are three major disciplines of Lent. The first is prayer (and there is help offered to you about prayer – see below.) The second is the giving of money to the needy. We have anticipated this with the collection for Haiti, but there will be other chances to give, especially to the Africa Fund. The third is “giving something up” - and you can use your imagination to think of ways in which you could do this.*

Ash Wednesday is a day of fasting and abstinence from meat. Abstinence begins when you are 14 years old and ends when you are 60! There are 2 Masses on Ash Wednesday: **9.30 am and 8.00 pm**. Going to daily Mass during Lent is a good discipline of letting the Lord come closer to us.

How can I pray better? As part of the 40th anniversary of the Church, there will be two meetings helping us to pray. They are on March 2nd and 9th from 7.30 – 9.00 pm in the Keenan Rooms. The two sessions will be run by lay people.
